2014 ITS Georgia Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarship

The ITS Georgia Chapter supports student involvement in the engineering profession, and hopes to encourage future Georgia ITS Engineers through the Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarship Program.

The ITS Georgia Chapter may award up to three scholarships, depending upon the number and quality of applications that are received. All award decisions will be made after a review by the Scholarship Committee and action by the Board of Directors. The Chapter reserves the right to reject any of the submissions should they be found inadequately prepared or non-responsive. ITS Georgia has budgeted up to \$3000 in scholarships for 2014. Applications for the ITS Georgia Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarships will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Students must be enrolled in an ABET accredited university in Georgia.
2. Each applicant shall submit a transcript for any college coursework completed (an unofficial transcript is acceptable). A GPA of 3.0 or higher is required.
3. The candidate should be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in a transportation related field, computer engineering or electrical engineering.
4. Applicants are asked to submit an essay (maximum of 700 words) in response to the following essay question:

“What are the top benefits and challenges of implementing autonomous vehicles in metro Atlanta?”

The ITS Georgia Scholarship Committee will select the winner(s) based on a review of their application, transcript and essay. The scholarship winner(s) will be notified by October 17, 2014. The scholarship recipient will be required to attend the ITS Georgia Awards Banquet, to be held at The Crown Ravinia in Atlanta, Georgia on November 6, 2014 from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm. The scholarship award will be formally presented at the Awards Banquet. The scholarship winner is required to make a presentation elaborating on their responses to the essay question at the ITS Georgia Monthly Meeting in February 2015.

Please complete the application (include your name in the header) and return to Kristin Turner no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, October 3, 2014. The application must be scanned and emailed with appropriate signatures before the deadline.

Attach additional sheets if necessary, but **information not specifically requested in the application form will be discarded.**
