2017 ITS Georgia Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarship

The ITS Georgia Chapter supports student involvement in the engineering profession, and hopes to encourage future Georgia ITS Engineers through the Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarship Program.

The ITS Georgia Chapter may award multiple scholarships, depending upon the number and quality of applications that are received. All award decisions will be made after a review by the Scholarship Committee and action by the Board of Directors. The Chapter reserves the right to reject any or all of the submissions should they be found inadequately prepared, or the content unacceptable. Applications for the ITS Georgia Wayne Shackelford Engineering Scholarships will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

1. Students must be enrolled in an ABET accredited university in Georgia.
2. Each applicant shall submit a transcript for any college coursework completed (an unofficial transcript is acceptable). A GPA of 3.0 or higher is required.
3. The candidate should be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in a transportation related field, such as civil engineering, urban planning, computer engineering, electrical engineering, or mechatronics engineering.
4. Applicants are asked to submit an essay (maximum of 1,000 words) in response to the following prompt:

“What Smart City applications or Internet of Things (IoT) technologies do you think governments should be utilizing now to improve overall mobility in their urban regions? Describe your proposed technologies and the expected benefits.”

Complete this application and **return (with transcript and essay) to Keary Lord (keary.lord@atkinsglobal.com) no later than midnight on Friday, October 13, 2017**. The application must be scanned and emailed with appropriate signatures before the deadline.

Every scholarship recipient is encouraged to attend the ITS Georgia Chapter Meeting, to be held on October 25 at Maggiano’s (Cumberland Mall Location), to receive their scholarship check and plaque. Scholarship winners are responsible for their transportation costs, but their registration costs for the meeting will be paid by ITS Georgia.

Scholarship winners will be required to make a presentation elaborating on their responses to their essay response at the ITS Georgia Monthly Meeting held in January 2018. Scholarship winners are responsible for their transportation costs, but their registration costs for the meeting will be paid by ITS Georgia.
